- 3 Robert Russa Moton Museum** (5.7 miles from campus) – Learn about the history of Prince Edward County, specifically as it relates to the role its citizens played in America's struggle to move from a segregated to an integrated society. 6 J Fergeson Gallery (7 miles from campus) – The J Fergeson Gallery brings together the work of nationally-recognized and local artists and features contemporary paintings, ceramics, sculpture, and photography. Open Tuesday – Saturday from 11 a.m. – 5:30 p.m.

7 High Bridge Trail State Park (8.5 miles from campus) – The newly renovated High Bridge Trail is a multi-use trail suited for hiking, bicycling, and horseback riding. Its centerpiece is the majestic High Bridge, which is more than 2,400 feet long and 125 feet above the Appomattox River.

10 The Museum of the Confederacy – Appomattox (25 miles from campus) – Learn about our nation's past in a place that witnessed it firsthand. Open 10 a.m. – 5 p.m. daily. 11 Red Hill (40 miles from campus) – Red Hill is Patrick Henry's last home and burial place. There you will find his home, law office, and his final resting place. Admission is \$6 for adults and \$2 for children. Red Hill is open Monday – Saturday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m. and Sunday 1 p.m. – 5 p.m.
