Early Intervention Services

Health Care Reform requires <u>unlimited benefits on early intervention services</u>. Effective January 1, 2014, early intervention services will be unlimited (currently limited to \$5,000 per year). Early Intervention services are defined as medically necessary Speech and Language Therapy, Occupational Therapy, Physical Therapy and assistive technology services and devices for dependents from birth to age 3 who are certified by the Department of Mental Health, Mental Retardation and Substance Abuse Services as eligible for services under Part H of the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.
