LIBRARY HIGHLIGHTS

- The Technology Commons and Academic Success Offices have moved to the library's main floor, and the ground floor is now the location for the Fuqua Computing Center.
- Our group learning spaces are becoming even more popular.
 - o The duPont classroom is fully booked with classroom activities.
 - o After 6 p.m., group study rooms are constantly in use by students for study, group work, and peer tutoring. There were 4,276 study room uses in 2015-16.
 - o The fourth floor has become a center for students seeking a comfortable place to work and study, as well as a popular place for events such as poetry readings.
 - We have added a silent study area on the ground floor and an additional study room on the third floor, bringing the total number of study rooms to 11.
- The College has migrated from the Blackboard course management system to Canvas.
 Faculty training sessions were offered starting in late summer 2016, and training is available by request as needed.
- The library home page is accessed over 100,000 times per year.
- The library has an average of 4,000 student visits a week during academic sessions.
- The library will once again be open for 24 hours during both semester exam weeks.
- The library has added digital copies of all Hampden-Sydney yearbooks, alumni magazines, and the Spalding Map Collection.
- We now have over 2,241 streaming videos cataloged and ready for group or individual use.
- The main library homepage was viewed 112,798 times during the 2015-16 academic year.
- The new FTC features 13 27" iMac computers, some with specialized software such as Final Cut X and Logic Pro X.
- The library has standard monochrome printing freely available from any computer in the library. Additionally, we provide access to wireless printing from your own device and color printing for academic work only.
- The library has a total of 39 publicly available computers that students can use with an additional 14 laptops (both PC and Mac) that students can check out for in-library use.
