Where is the Health Center located?

204 College Rd...5 houses down from the Business Office

What are the Health Center hours?

Currently the hours are 7:30 AM to 4:00 PM Monday – Friday but this might change slightly and will be clearly stated on signage and on the website.

What if the student is sick on weekends or after hours?

Centra Health offers a walk-in clinic from 8 AM – 8PM Monday – Saturday. Southside Community Hospital Emergency Room is open 24/7.

Are vaccines available?

The Health Center has Tetanus (Td and Tdap) and Influenza vaccines at no charge to the student. Other vaccines may be available at Prince Edward County Health Department on Tuesdays and most are available at Pharmacies.

What if I am sick and don't go to class? Do I need an excuse?

The Health Center does not provide excuses for class. It is the student's responsibility to contact the professor. Each professor explains their attendance policies in their syllabus. If a student is sent to the Emergency Room or sent home, a letter will be sent to the student's professors and advisor.

How do I pay for my visit to the Health Center?

There is no charge for the services of the Health Center. If lab testing, x-ray or referral to a specialist is ordered, the student's insurance will be billed.

Can the Health Center provide medication?

The Health Center only has limited over the counter medications available. The Health Center does not have a Pharmacy. Prescription medications must be obtained from a local pharmacy. Currently the town of Farmville has a CVS, Walgreen, Walmart and Farmville Family Pharmacy. Some have limited delivery services.

I take ADD medication. Can I get refills at the Health Center?

Dr. Corbett can prescribe your medications if he has your academic testing results done within the past three years on file. You will have to see him monthly for your refill.

How do I make an appointment?
