Calendar: The academic year comprises a fall and spring semester and a 4 week May term. Credits are reported in semester hours.

Dean's List: The Dean's List is compiled at the end of each semester. It lists students who have earned at least a 3.3 grade point average that semester, for at least 15 credit hours of work.

Transfer Courses: Students may receive credit hours for college courses taken at another institution if they earn a grade of C or higher. The grade and hours earned are entered on the transcript, but no quality points are given and the grade-point average is unaffected.

Graduation Honors: Graduation with honors is awarded to students who meet the following requirements:

Repeat of Courses: A student may repeat once any previously passed course. However, the student will receive credit for the course only once. The grade from the first time the course was taken will remain on the transcript. Hours attempted and quality points earned will be counted for both times the course is taken and will be included in the computation of the cumulative GPA. A student may repeat a previously failed course until he passes it. However, all failing grades earned in the course remain on the transcript and are included in the computation of the cumulative GPA.
