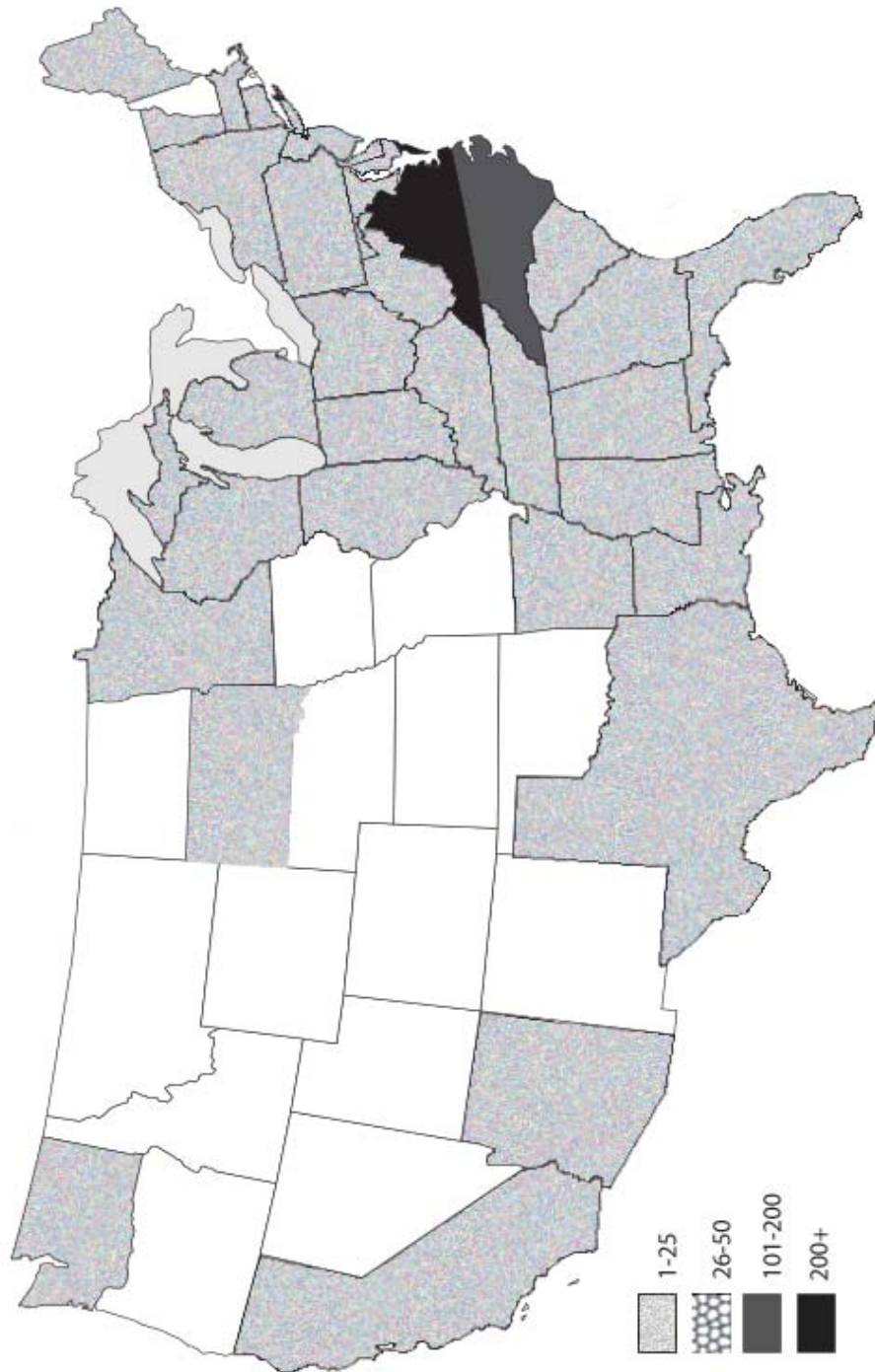

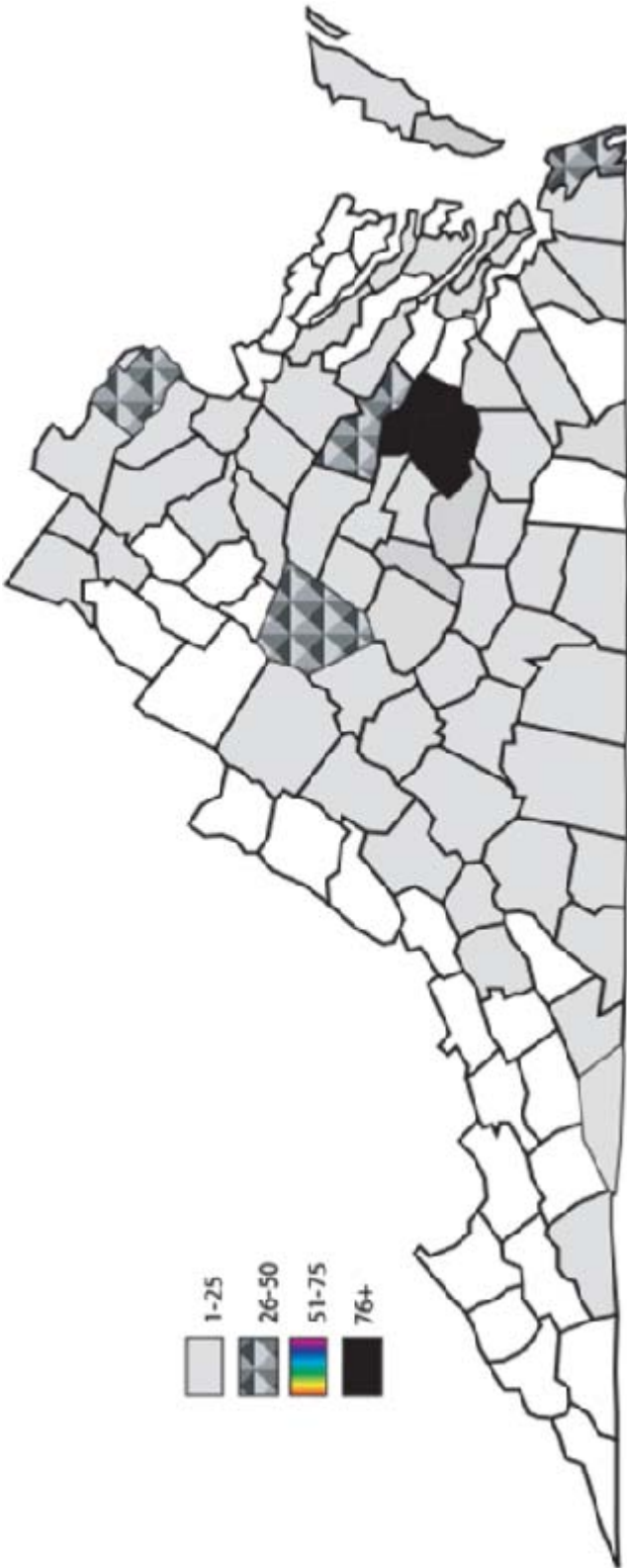

2013-14 MAP OF VIRGINIA STUDENTS BY COUNTY



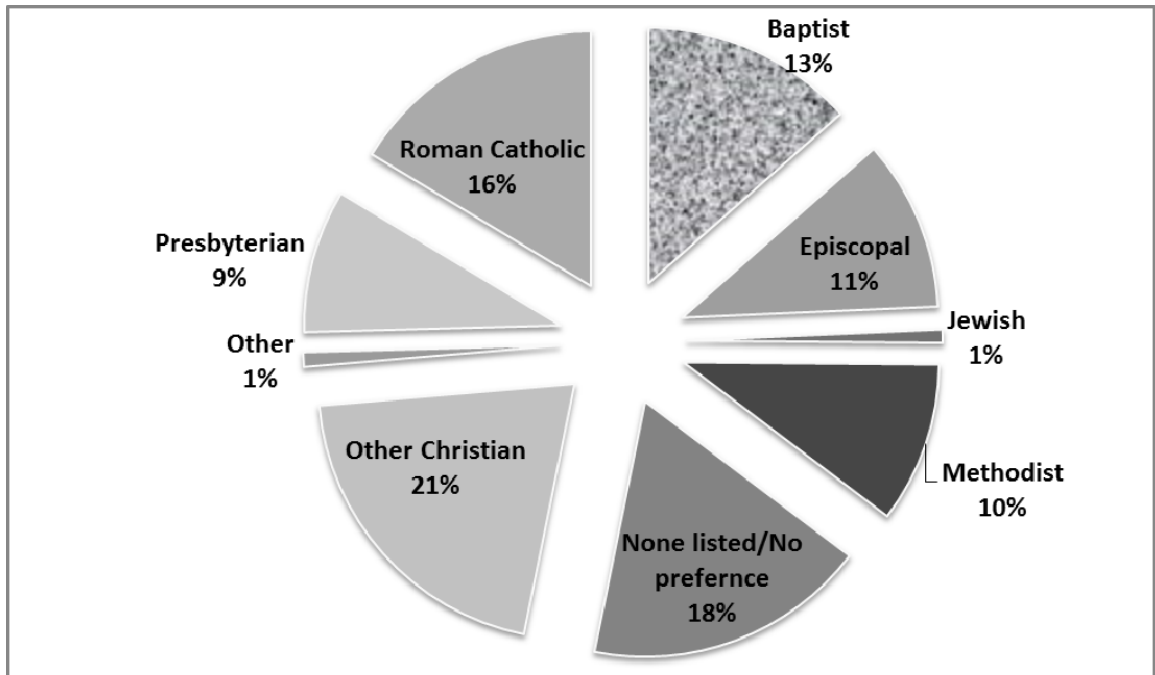
