Welcome to our Fall 2019 Calculus II class! This message contains important information about <u>WebAssign</u>, a website that you will be using to do homework assignments and other activities daily throughout the semester.

WebAssign is required for the course, so please read this message carefully!

## WebAssign Online Homework System and eBook

Our course features an **online homework system** and an **eBook** on the WebAssign website. Almost all the homework for the course will be done using the online homework system. The eBook is "Calculus", tenth edition, by Larson and Edwards. It is identical to the hardcopy version of the book, and in addition contains video tutorials and other features.

If you had Calculus I with me or have used WebAssign before, then your existing WebAssign account should still be active.

If you have not used WebAssign before, you will need to sign up for access.

## Signing Up For WebAssign

You need to sign-up for WebAssign by the beginning of class. Here's how to do that:

- 1. Point your browser to https://www.webassign.net/login.html
- 2. Click on the button that says "Enter Class Key" (towards the middle right of the webpage).
- 3. You will be prompted to enter a Class Key. The class key for this course is

- 4. Next you should be sent to a page that says your Class Key has been recognized. If you do not already have a WebAssign account, click "Create Account", and follow the instructions there. If you already have a WebAssign account, sign into that.
- 5. You will be taken to the homepage for this class. Note that you have a grace period for free access to WebAssign. After the grace period ends you will no longer be able to see your WebAssign assignments or grades, until you purchase access.

## Purchasing the Online Homework System and eBook

Once you've signed up for WebAssign, you should purchase the Online Homework System and eBook.

- 1. If you're not already logged in, log into your WebAssign account.
- Select the option "purchase access online"
- 3. You will be presented with two options for purchase. Which option should you select? That depends on your academic plans. If you do intend to take more Calculus courses, you should purchase "Lifetime of Edition access to homework and eBook." With this option, you can continue to use the eBook for subsequent Calculus classes even if your instructor doesn't use WebAssign. If you do not intend to take more Calculus, you might only need "Single-term access to homework and eBook." Select the option you prefer, and complete the purchase. You will need a credit card in order to complete the purchase.
