The Military Leadership and National Security minor is designed for students who are interested in the historical, political, cultural, ethical, and legal dimensions of national security policy as well as the place and role of the military in American society.

Students enrolled in the minor must complete one required course during each of their final three years at Hampden-Sydney College.

Students must also complete at least 2 courses from **separate** departments, selected from: ENGL 194; GVFA 230 or INDS 375; GVFA 242, 342 or HIST 313; GVFA 442; INDS 465; PHIL 314 or RELI 225; PSYC 310; RELI 103; and RHET 210.

Military Leadership and National Security Certificate Program: Students who wish to be considered for participation in the Military Leadership and National Security Studies Certificate Program must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 and must submit an application to Professor Simms by **November 1st of their sophomore year.** Participation in this program will enrich the college experience of all students, and particularly those enrolled in the ROTC program or those who hold positions with National Guard or Reserve units; however, students need not be in the ROTC program. Enrollment in the ROTC program does not guarantee admission to the certificate program.
