

SMART GOALS AND MATURE MEASURES

WHEN WRITING LEARNING OUTCOMES OR UNIT GOALS, THINK <u>SMART</u>

- <u>Specific</u>: States exactly what is expected using concrete action verbs.
- <u>Measurable: Requires a measurable result.</u>
- <u>A</u>ttainable: Is achievable yet reasonably stretches the unit.
- <u>R</u>ealistic: Is reasonable and appropriate for the unit's services/work.
- <u>T</u>ime-oriented: Describes when a goal will be achieved within a specified time period.

WHEN MEASURING OUTCOMES OR UNIT GOALS, THINK <u>MATURE</u>

- <u>Matches</u>: Directly related to the outcome it is measuring.
- <u>Appropriate methods</u>: Uses appropriate direct or indirect measures.
- <u>Targets</u>: Indicates a desired level of performance.
- <u>U</u>seful: Measures help identify what to improve.
- <u>R</u>eliable: Based on tested, known methods.
- <u>Effective and Efficient</u>: Characterizes the outcome concisely.
