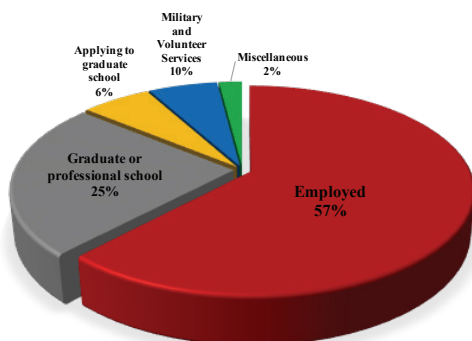
HONOR AND CHARACTER

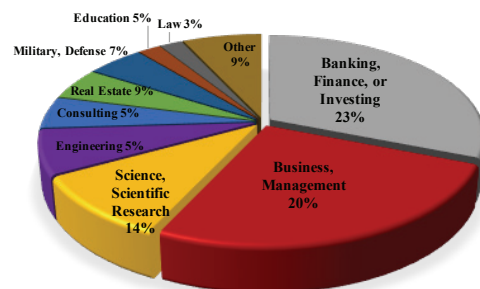

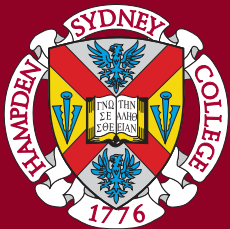
The *Honor Code* also applies at all times and in all places: “The Hampden-Sydney student will not lie, cheat, or steal, nor tolerate those who do.”
